



ICTA MIXED LEAGUE – YEAR END TOURNAMENT RULES

The ICTA Mixed League Year End Tournament is an opportunity for those teams that have excelled in league play during the year to compete at the year-end tournament to crown the level champions. The results of this tournament are supplemental to the season and do not affect promotion and relegation for teams in any way.

To all of those competing, we wish you the best of luck.

SECTION 1 – TEAM ELIGIBILITY

- 1.1 Teams who finish first or second in their division are eligible for tournament play.
- 1.2 If the number of divisions at a level allows for additional teams to be added to fill out the draw (eg. Mixed B & C in 2017), third place teams across all divisions with the most points will be added.
- 1.3 Only points recorded by:
 - I. End of Day on August 25, 2016 for Majors
 - II. End of Day on August 28, 2017 for A
 - III. End of Day on August 18, 2017 for B
 - IV. End of Day on August 21, 2017 for Cwill be considered for seeding calculations.

SECTION 2 – PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Only players in good standing are eligible to play in the year end tournament. All players have to have been included on the roster before the end of week 9, and have played 3 matches for their team (regardless of the number of fixtures in the division) to be eligible for tournament play. All players must still qualify to play on the team in question to play in the year end tournament.



SECTION 3 - DRAW

- 3.1 Teams will be seeded in the draw according to their winning percentage that they earned during the regular season.
- 3.2 WINNING PERCENTAGE = NUMBER OF POINTS WON / TOTAL NUMBER OF POINTS AVAILABLE TO BE WON
- 3.3 In the event of tie between teams, that tie will be broken by:
 - I. SETS WON divided by TOTAL SETS PLAYED
 - II. GAMES WON divided by TOTAL GAMES PLAYED
 - III. Coin Toss
- 3.4 First and second place teams from the same division will not be seeded on the same side of the draw. This may affect seeding slightly.
- 3.5 In all cases, first place teams will be seeded above second place teams and all second place teams will be seeded above third place teams.
- 3.6 The top ranked team will be seeded against the lowest rated team on their side of the draw.
- 3.7 The highest seeded team playing in a tournament fixture is always the home team unless by mutual agreement.
- 3.8 Home teams are responsible for providing refreshments. Visiting teams will provide 6 sleeves of tournament quality balls.

SECTION 4 – PLAYOFF TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- 4.1 The Mixed League rules will govern all fixtures except as specifically outlined in these tournament rules.
- 4.2 Fixtures during the final at the Aviva Centre may be subject to some rule changes due to time or court availability.

SECTION 5 – WINNING TOURNAMENT FIXTURES

- 5.1 Winning teams will be determined in the following manner
 - I. Matches won
 - II. Sets won (including super-tie breaks)
 - III. Games won
 - IV. Winner of L, X1, M1
- 5.2 Majors teams will play the best of home and away matches with the results as determined in section 5.1.



SECTION 6 – RECORDING RESULTS

- 6.1 Fixture results must be submitted within 24 hours of the matches to the tournament director.

SECTION 7 – RAINOUTS

- 7.1 Tournament matches delayed by rain must be completed by the end of day on the following Sunday for Majors and B, and by end of day on the following Tuesday for A and C.
- 7.2 Scores must be recorded on the same day that matches are completed.
- 7.3 If matches are not completed on time, decisions on who will advance will be made by the Tournament Director.

SECTION 8 - GRIEVANCES

- 8.1 All grievances about any fixture must be filed within 48 hours of the match to the Tournament Director.
- 8.2 All decisions made by the Tournament Director are final and binding.
